
ORDER

THIS CAUSE is before the Court on Plaintiff's Motion for Entry of Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Relief Against Defendants MJ Capital Funding, LLC and MJ Taxes and More, Inc. (DE [61]), filed September 21, 2021.
