

**ORDER**

**THIS CAUSE** is before the Court on Plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission's Motion to Amend Complaint (DE [115]), wherein Plaintiff seeks leave to amend the Complaint (DE [1]) to add additional facts regarding the Ponzi scheme orchestrated by Defendants Johanna M. Garcia ("Garcia") and her companies MJ Capital Funding, LLC ("MJ Capital") and MJ Taxes and More, Inc. ("MJ Taxes", together with MJ Capital, the "MJ Companies") (collectively, "Defendants"). Counsel for the Receiver had no objection to the proposed relief. Defendant advised it would reserve the right to object after reviewing the motion, however, the time to respond has expired and no objection has been filed. Accordingly, the Motion to Amend Complaint (DE [115]) is unopposed. Having considered the motion, the record, and finding that good cause exists, it is hereby

**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that the Motion to Amend Complaint (DE [115]) is **GRANTED**. Plaintiff must separately re-file its Amended Complaint (DE [115-1]) pursuant to Local Rule 15.1, by **March 24, 2022**.
