
ORDER GRANTING JOINT REQUEST TO STAY

THIS CAUSE is before the Court on the Motion for Expedited Ruling on Joint Notice of Partial Settlement with Defendant Johanna M. Garcia and Joint Request for Stay (DE [165]). Plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission (the “SEC”) and Defendant Johanna M. Garcia (“Defendant”) have reached a settlement on non-monetary relief and Defendant has consented to entry of a permanent injunction. See (DE [151]). The SEC and Defendant request a stay as to the SEC’s request for monetary relief in light of the “parallel federal criminal investigation.” Based on good cause appearing on the record, and being advised that Receivership Defendants MJ Capital Funding, LLC and MJ Taxes and More, Inc. have no objection to the proposed relief, it is hereby

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

1. The Motion for Expedited Ruling on Joint Notice of Partial Settlement with Defendant Johanna M. Garcia and Joint Request for Stay (DE [165]) is **GRANTED**.
2. This case is **STAYED** as to the SEC's request for monetary relief.
3. The SEC may bring the appropriate disgorgement and civil penalty motion against Defendant, if necessary, once her criminal sentencing has been completed (in the event Defendant does not prevail at trial); and ninety (90) days after Defendant's sentencing to obtain authority from the Commission to request a specific disgorgement and/or penalty amount as needed.
4. Nothing herein stays or otherwise impacts the Receiver and her ongoing rights and duties under the Receivership Order (DE [17]) and Expansion Order (DE [79]).
5. Furthermore, all deadlines are **TERMINATED**, and all hearings are **CANCELLED**.
