ORDER GRANTING FINAL JUDGMENT AS TO DEFENDANT JOHANNA M. GARCIA

THIS CAUSE comes before the Court on Plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission's ("SEC") Motion for Final Judgment Against Defendant Johanna M. Garcia (the "Motion") (DE [284]), filed on March 31, 2025. The Court has reviewed the Motion and the Proposed Judgment (DE [284-4]) and is otherwise fully advised in the premises. The Court also notes that no objections have been filed.

The SEC commenced this action by filing its Complaint against Defendant Johanna M. Garcia ("Defendant"). This Court previously entered Judgment, by consent, against Defendant which entered injunctive relief, an officer and director bar, and other relief, but left unresolved the issues of disgorgement and prejudgment interest. See the Judgment at (DE [169]). The Court finds that good cause exists to award the Commission disgorgement and prejudgment interest in the amounts set forth in the Motion.

Accordingly, it is hereby **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that Plaintiff SEC's Motion for Final Judgment Against Defendant Johanna M. Garcia (DE [284]) is **GRANTED**. The

Court will separately enter a Final Judgment against Johanna M. Garcia, pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. Rule 58(a). The Clerk is directed to **CLOSE** this case.
